The larger model of a Beyer-Garratt style includes working-style features such as labelled switches for "chuffer" and "smoke," brass detailing, buffers, and couplings. Both display very well with light surface wear from handling. Superb display pieces of Meccano railway engineering, unchecked for operation or completeness.


